The purpose of this document is to show you how to configure Extra Products to be displayed on the Digital Fleet Tablet/Driver Application. High level in order to do so, the dispatch category codes need to be added to the Client Info page in Settings. We will look at the XML Digital Fleet receives from Dispatch to find the category codes.

Looking at the XML (excerpt), the first product listed (highlighted in yellow) in the received dispatch XML file is considered the Main Product for the ticket and any additional products listed are considered Extra Products. The category codes for the additional products (highlighted in green) follow.



In this example, we have three category codes: 932, 847, 931.

To show the Extra Products on the Digital Fleet driver app, the dispatch category codes need to be added to the Client Info page of the Settings. This can be accomplished by a Client Administrator under the “Misc Settings” by specifying the desired category codes in the Extra Product Codes field and selecting Save.



**Misc Settings**

Extra Product Codes:	<input type="text" value="932, 847, 931"/>

By specifying the category codes, this ensures only relevant items are displayed to the driver.
