

This document is to outline the requirements defined by the Electronic Logging Device Mandate and provide a listing of available Digital Fleet documentation related to the ELD feature.

### Mandatory Documents Required to be in the ELD Vehicle

- 1. ELD User's Manual
- 2. <u>Instruction sheet</u> for transferring HOS records to safety officials.
- Instruction sheet on reporting ELD malfunctions and recordkeeping procedures during ELD malfunctions.
- 4. A supply of paper tracking forms (grid graphs) for at least 8 days, in case of ELD malfunction.

#### **FMCSA Recommended Training for the Drivers**

- 1. As recommended in the <u>ELD Checklist for Drivers</u>, the driver should understand how to do the following. Instructions are available in the ELD User's Manual along with the instruction sheets for transferring of HOS records and ELD malfunctions.
  - a. Log in
  - b. Respond to unassigned driving hours the ELD records
  - c. Record duty status changes
  - d. Edit records
  - e. Add notes to records to explain any edits or additions
  - f. Certify records to indicate that they are complete and accurate
  - g. Access RODS data from the ELD
  - h. Review and understand the ELD printout/display information
  - i. Transfer ELD data by email or Blue Tooth to inspectors or law enforcement
  - j. Identify and correct or report data diagnostic issues
  - k. Report ELD malfunctions
